

Freight Room and Blue Room

The Georgia Railroad Freight Depot was completed in April of 1869 and is one of the oldest buildings in downtown Atlanta. The building served as the main freight depot for the Georgia Railroad and was restored by the Georgia Building Authority in 1981 for public use. Most of the original brickwork and freight bays remain in place to give the facility a unique setting for special occasions. The Freight Room can accommodate 800 guests for a seated event and 1300 for a stand-up reception. The room offers a permanent gazebo, two antique buggies and a raised stage. The Freight Room is an ideal location for large award ceremonies, wedding receptions, lunch and dinner events, trade shows, or fundraisers with sufficient room for a DJ, band or other entertainment. You are only limited by your own imagination.

The Blue Room is a quaint catering and meeting facility within the Freight Depot used for mid-size gatherings. The Blue Room's hardwood floors and two fireplaces give it an antique look that creates a beautiful setting. The Blue Room seats 150 guests and can house 200 people for a standing reception. The Blue Room is often used for breakfasts, luncheons, dinners, fundraisers, meetings and receptions.

Directions to the Freight Room and Blue Room

Northbound on I-75/85: • Exit at Central Avenue/Fulton St. • Take a right at first light • Take a left at next light, onto Capitol Avenue • Take a left onto MLK, Jr. Drive, pass the Capitol on your left • Go through intersection with Washington St., the Georgia Freight Depot will be on your right, underneath the large mural of whales

Southbound on I-75-85: • Exit at Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive/State Capitol • Go straight through three lights, pass the Capitol on your left • The Georgia Freight Depot will be on your right, underneath the large mural of whales

Empire Room

Located on the 20th floor of the James H. "Sloppy" Floyd Building just across from Georgia's State Capitol building, the Empire Room offers guests a spectacular view of Underground Atlanta, the State Capitol and Turner Field baseball stadium. A view that is spectacular in the day becomes extraordinary after dark. The Empire room offers a dance floor, coat check and small lounge area. This facility will comfortably house 125 guests for a seated event and 200 guests for a standing reception.

Directions to the Empire Room

Northbound on I-75/85: • Exit at Central Avenue/Fulton St. • Take a right at first light • Take a left at next light, onto Capitol Avenue • When Capitol Avenue turns into Piedmont, Sloppy Floyd Building is on right • Empire Room is on 20th floor of building

Southbound on I-75-85: • Exit at Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive/State Capitol • Go straight through first light at Jesse Hill, Jr. Drive • Sloppy Floyd Building is immediately on right • Empire Room is on 20th floor of building

Floyd Room

Located on the 20th floor of the James H. "Sloppy" Floyd Building just across from Georgia's State Capitol building, the Floyd Room offers a stunning view of Underground Atlanta and the downtown area. On a clear day, visitors to the Floyd Room can see as far as Georgia's Stone Mountain. The Floyd Room, complete with a dance floor, can accommodate 300 guests for a seated event and 450 for a stand-up reception. The Floyd Room is an ideal location for breakfast meetings, seminars, luncheons or evening receptions.

Directions to The Floyd Room

Northbound on I-75/85: • Exit at Central Avenue/Fulton St. • Take a right at first light • Take a left at next light, onto Capitol Avenue • When Capitol Avenue turns into Piedmont, Sloppy Floyd Building is on right • Floyd Room is on 20th floor of building

Southbound on I-75-85: • Exit at Martin Luther King Jr., Drive/State Capitol • Go straight through first light at Jesse Hill, Jr. Drive • Sloppy Floyd Building is immediately on right • Floyd Room is on 20th floor of building

Georgia Room

Located on the 20th floor of the James H. "Sloppy" Floyd Building just across from Georgia's State Capitol building, the Georgia Room offers guests a spectacular view of Underground Atlanta. A view that is spectacular in the day becomes extraordinary after dark. This facility will comfortably house 40 guests for a seated event, 60 guests for a standing reception and 30 guests for a classroom style event.

Directions to the Georgia Room

Northbound on I-75/85: • Exit at Central Avenue/Fulton St. • Take a right at first light • Take a left at next light, onto Capitol Avenue • When Capitol Avenue turns into Piedmont, Sloppy Floyd Building is on right • Georgia Room is on 20th floor of building

Southbound on I-75-85: • Exit at Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive/State Capitol • Go straight through first light at Jesse Hill, Jr. Drive • Sloppy Floyd Building is immediately on right • Georgia Room is on 20th floor of building
